Our learning will cover...

- Observing colours in the natural environment.

- Using tablets to record images.

Communication and Language

Our learning will cover...

- Further developing our abilities to take turns in everyday conversations.
- Helping us to improve our listening skills when others are talking.
- Opportunities for us to join in with daily stories and discussions.
- Activities where we can discuss both familiar, unfamiliar stories and rhymes.
- Being introduced to stories by different authors.

RE

Our learning will cover...

- Finding out about autumn and harvest.
- Starting to explore other people's beliefs through our 'Faith Friends'.

Literacy

Our learning will cover...

- Learning to recognise letters by sound in our daily phonic sessions.
- Starting to recognise simple everyday words including our names.
- Opportunities to freely experiment with writing during our play.
- Activities that will encourage us to begin to use letters or symbols, remembering to ascribe meaning to our marks.

Maths

Our learning will cover...

- Sorting objects by shape, size and colour.
- Joining in when counting to at least 20 and backwards from 10.
- Learning new number rhymes and songs.
- Using number names to accurately count different numbers of objects.
- Being helped to try and use our mathematical knowledge to begin to solve simple everyday problems.

Physical Development

Our learning will cover...

- Moving confidently and safely during P.E. and in our play.
- Working on our fine and gross motor skills through a variety of different activities.
- Learning to control the equipment we use when drawing, writing, cutting, painting and using a computer.
- Learning to explore malleable materials such as playdough.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Our learning will cover...

- Learning to uphold the school and classroom rules.
- Beginning to think carefully about our rights and responsibilities.
- Learning strategies that enable us to play co-operatively.
- Knowing how to take responsibility for our own personal hygiene.
- Developing our skills of independence when selecting activities and resources.
- Exploring ways to take care of our school and wider environment.
- Considering similarities and differences between ourselves and others.
- Sharing with others our own needs, wants, interests and opinions.
- Exploring our feelings and thinking about how these can impact both ourselves and others.
